ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP STANDARDS AND PROCESS

TERMS

- 1.) The Scholarship is sponsored by the Northern British Columbia Recreation Association
- 2.) The value of the scholarship is \$1,000
- 3.) More than one applicant may be accepted

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1.) Must be from one of the following northern communities: Chetwynd, Dawson Creek, Pouce Coupe, Fort Nelson, Fort St. John, Taylor, Hudson's Hope, Mackenzie, Prespatou, or Tumbler Ridge and surrounding communities
- 2.) The applicant must be attending a post-secondary school, or
- 3.) Must be registered at a recognized university or college in one of the following: recreation, physical education, leisure studies, or kinesiology. If no applications are received for students going into any of the listed fields of study, other applicants may be considered

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1.) Email a cover letter requesting that you be considered for the scholarship. The letter should include your name, mailing address and telephone number
- 2.) Attach a 500 to 1000 word essay describing what you have done to positively affect your community, and what your plans are once you have completed your education

The successful applicant must email proof of acceptance at a recognized advanced education institution and the course of studies as listed in the above eligibility criteria and if currently graduating a certified copy of their final Grade 12 transcripts in order to receive the scholarship money.
