## **ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP STANDARDS AND PROCESS**

### **TERMS**

- 1.) The Scholarship is sponsored by the Northern British Columbia Recreation Association.
- 2.) The value of the scholarship is \$1,000.
- 3.) More than one applicant may be accepted

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- 1.) Must be from one of the following northern communities: Chetwynd, Dawson Creek, Fort Nelson, Fort St. John, Hudson's Hope, Mackenzie, Taylor or Tumbler Ridge and / or surrounding areas.
- 2.) Anyone attending post-secondary school.
- 3.) Must be registered at a recognized university or college in one of the following: recreation, physical education, leisure studies, or kinesiology. If no applications are received for students going into any of the listed fields of study, other applicants may be considered.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- 1.) Email a cover letter requesting that you be considered for the scholarship. The letter should include your name, mailing address and telephone number.
- 2.) Attach a 500 to 1000 word essay on what you have done for your community and what your plans are once you have completed your education.
